


Figure 1.1 World economic history in one picture. Incomes rose sharply in many countries after 1800 but declined in others.




World Income Distribution






Figure 1. The Kuznets Curve. Scatterplot and Nonparametric Regression Curve Showing the Relationship of Income Inequality to Energy Consumption per Capita: 277 Observations from 88 Countries, 1952–1988




Fig. 4.2. Gini index of market income (percent)





Fig. 4.5. Gini index of disposable income (percent)



Change in Personal Earnings between 1990 and 2009-2011








Fig. 2. Ratio of percentage of women to men employed in the last week, age 25 to 54, 1970 to 2018. Source: Authors' computations from IPUMS CPS ASEC samples for 1970 to 2018.

- Leicht (2008) ARS
- Racial gaps in earnings had declined until the early 1980s.
- Racial stratification has declined even after the 1980s (Zhou 2012, Sociological Methodology).
- Gender gaps in earnings has declined continously.
- However, within-group inequality has grown.
- "Study earnings distributions, not means of the distribution" (Leicht 2008, p.250).


